The Bishop's cassock has 33 buttons. The 33 buttons represent our Lord Christ's earthly years. The cassock also has 5 buttons on each wrist.

The 5 buttons on each wrist represent the 5 wounds Jesus suffered on the cross. When the priest's hands are held together, these 5 buttons from each hand become 10 in total and represent the Ten Commandments.
